





So what are you focusing upon and sending out with your thoughts? What kind of influence are you creating upon the world with your thoughts?

We the people of Earth can create peace on Earth by creating more positivity for the world. If you are unhappy, think about what you have been doing





lately, how have you been spending your time? What percent of your time has been positive versus negative?

If you have been creating positivity, you are quite likely happy. If you have been focusing on negative communications and actions, you are unhappy. Go about and get active in creating good effects for you and others. Keep an ever-watchful and vigilant eye upon your mental wellbeing and happiness. Always stay positive in your response, actions, and thoughts.

This is one of the most important initiatives on Earth today that can create peace on Earth for everyone. With all of your efforts to be a positive influence upon the world, you are an important part of the team, and you have a part in making this happen. Phase One of our program is to reach two billion people and positively influence them to stay positive in their actions. Phase Two is to reach the rest of the world.







Luckily for Mikey and us, Mikey was vibrant, active, alive, playing, retrieving balls, etc., right up until the last day of his life. In the last two weeks of his life, he had become a finicky eater, but we changed his diet to a prescription diet and he loved that and continued to gobble that up with no problem. So we thought the crisis was over since he resumed hearty and enthusiastic eating.

I knew Mikey was going to go to Heaven when I saw him in that condition on the last day

of a pet, we are devastated and

heartbroken. However, as many

of you know from my posts, I

believe in past lives and future

lives. I believe our pets come back

to Heaven when I saw him in that condition on the last day of his life, so my last words to Mikey were my telling him that I love him, to come to the house and inhabit Mitzi so they could continue to be together in the form of a combined Mitzi with Mikey, and that would make Mitzi happy to feel his presence, and it would make us happy to feel his presence as well. I told him, when the time is right, we will get another dog to bring him back into our family.

I thanked him for being a part of our family and that we have been through this before, and we will always want him with us.

Since Mikey's passing, I have perceived his presence at the house, and I believe I have seen Mitzi perceive his presence as well.

Max, Meadow, and Mitzi all seem to be dealing very well with Mikey's passing compared to my husband and myself. But I do find it comforting to feel Mikey's presence at the house, and it makes me smile when I perceive it.

It is often hard for me to know in the spiritual universe what is real. I am so used to the physical presence where I can see my dog

with my eyes.

From all the things I feel, I believe Mikey is alive and well in the spiritual form and staying with us at the house. Several times, things have happened to let me know that.

Sometimes, Mitzi is now doing the things that Mikey would do. When I see that happen, it actually makes me smile quite a bit because it is somehow so funny to see it

happening. I feel like Mikey is telling me that he is here, and it is OK.

Mikey was a wonderful dog. He was so upbeat and enthusiastic and cute and playful. He loved belly rubs and was known in Idyllwild as the belly rub boy. I could ask him if he wanted a belly rub, and he would immediately roll over and get his belly rub. I love that he would do this on command of my asking the question. That always pleased people so much to see that he perfectly understood the English language. I would also quip that my dogs are the only politicians in the world that will close their mouths on command. I would then hold up a treat and ask Mikey to close his mouth, and he would do it flawlessly.

Because Mikey liked belly rubs so much, he was often lying down when out in the public. I used to always say he was undercover as a lazy dog, but believe me he's watching. Sure enough, if a dog went by, Mikey would pop right up and start barking. He was very alert and always watching everything.

He, along with his sister Mitzi, are known as the heads of security and the bodyguards for the Mayor. I came up with that idea when they started acting like guard dogs if a dog walked by. I thought it was funny, and it just sort of stuck. I also like the idea that the Mayor and Vice Mayor have a security detail. I think I will keep up that tradition.



Mitzi is now the head of the security team and carries on solo with this job. Mitzi, being the alpha dog of all of the Mayors, is up to the task with no problem.

Dedicated to ensuring the safety and well-being of every citizen and to keeping our beautiful Mountain Community "Fire Safe," here are fire prevention tips:

Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Detector Installation and Check

• Please make sure all of your smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors are installed, in good working order, and are tested monthly and after the batteries are changed annually.

Always Keep "Operating" Fire Extinguisher(s) on Hand and Close By in Your Home

Keep Your Chimney, Fireplaces, and Wood Stoves Clean:

- ◆ Have your chimney, fireplace, wood or pellet stove inspected and cleaned annually by a licensed chimney specialist.
- ◆ Be sure to keep the area around the hearth clear of debris, decorations, and any other combustible materials.
- If you have a wood burning, insert or pellet stove, refer to the manufacturer's instructions for additional guidance related to operation and venting.

Keep Fires Burning Safely

- Ensure that the flue is open before lighting your fire to help ensure the fireplace will vent properly. Do not close your damper until you are certain that the fire is out.
- ◆ When starting a fire, only use a match or commercial firelighter. Never use flammable liquids to start a fire.
- Glass doors of a fireplace should be kept open while burning a fire. This allows the fire
 to receive enough air for complete combustion and to help reduce creosote build-up in the
 chimney (refer to your manufacturer's user guide).
- ◆ Metal mesh screens should remain closed whenever your fireplace is in use to help ensure that embers remain in the fireplace.
- Only use dry wood in your fireplace. Wet wood can increase creosote buildup, which can lead to a chimney fire.
- Never burn plastic because it can release toxic chemicals and cause damage to your chimney, fireplace, or wood stove.
- Never burn Christmas trees in fireplaces as sparks from burning needles can increase chimney fire risk. Do not burn cardboard boxes, wrapping paper, or trash in your fireplace.
- ◆ Never leave a fire in a fireplace unattended. Before leaving the house or going to bed, you should make certain to fully extinguish the fire.
- Ensure that ashes cool completely before disposing of them (ashes can take many hours to several days to cool completely). Never empty ashes directly into a trash can; place ashes in an approved metal container located at least 10 feet away from buildings.
- Clear an area for your ash container that is free from any combustible materials. (Clear to mineral soil/dirt.) Do not place your ash container on your deck or other wooden surface.

Keep the Outside of Your Home and Your Chimney Safe

- Firewood should be stacked and covered at a minimum of 30 feet from your home.
- ◆ Your roof and chimney should be kept clean of leaves, pine needles, and other debris. Prune trees and branches to keep them away from your chimney.
- Install a chimney cap with spark arrester to help keep debris, leaves, branches, and animals out and to help prevent embers or sparks from escaping and creating a fire hazard.

Keep Your Home and Property Safe and Clear by Conducting Year-Round Fire Abatement.


